# Clarinettissimo Olympics 2025

The 2025 Clarinettissimo clarinet festival will take place on Saturday and Sunday, October 4 and 5.

The Clarinet Olympics is for students wishing to learn a new skill, meet peers, play together, win prizes, and have fun. Ages 8-18 welcome.

Students will play a scale, then as a clarinet choir, and win prizes. This year, the test is five scales related to a minor, and *Trio in a minor*. Students must play all the scales except the optional advanced scale, and also choose which part or parts they would like to play in *Trio in a minor*. Students are encouraged to practice all the parts of the trio.

## **Clarinet Olympics 2025**



a natural minor Same notes as C major, but start and end on A



a harmonic minor Same notes as natural minor, but raise the seventh note. In this case G#



a melodic minor Same notes as natural minor, but raise the 6th and 7th note ascending only In this case F# and G# Descending is natural minor



Or, you can think A major with a flat 3rd note (Ch) ascending, and C major descending.
